CLASS DESCRIPTION

My classes are designed to allow each student to release, self-express, cultivate community, and pay gratitude to their human vessel. We begin each class with a full body warm-up that includes mindfulness, cardio, strengthening, flexibility, and technique. After exploring a short movement phrase, choreography will be taught that builds from the focus in the warm-up. My style is highly expressive, musical, and intentional, offering dancers a unique fusion of contemporary, hip-hop, jazz, and modern techniques. It is my goal to have each person leave a stronger dancer, a more aware artist, and a super-empowered human.
